

ROBIN HOOD DRESS CODE

ON THE COURSE

ACCEPTABLE

Clothing

Members and visitors are expected to show respect for the Club environment, and for each other, by maintaining a good standard of clean and tidy dress at all times on the Course.

- **Gentlemen** are required to keep golf tops "tucked in" at all times.
- Tailored shorts of a reasonable length are allowed with knee length white socks or acceptable short white socks this includes trainers or "short cut" white socks.
- **Ladies** The wearing of shorts of a reasonable length with mainly white socks or "short cut" socks or socks matching their outfit is acceptable.
- The Professional usually carries a stock of acceptable Gents and Ladies socks.
- Ladies may wear sleeveless tops with built up shoulders

Ladies are requested to observe the spirit of the dress code where, because of differences in male and female attire, it is inappropriate for them to observe the code to the letter.

Caps

- Caps are to be worn peak to the front.

Footwear

- All players must wear golf shoes on the course.

NOT ACCEPTABLE

Clothing

- Jeans
- Emblazoned team sport shirts (e.g. football, rugby and cricket) or collarless tee shirts (other than those specifically designed for golf)
- Trousers and any shorts with visible outside pockets (combats)
- Track suits.

Ladies

- Summer dresses and tops with straps are not allowed.

Changing in the Car Park

- The changing of shoes or clothing in the car park.

Footwear

- Trainers and all other non-golf footwear.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Robin Hood Golf Club operates a SMART CASUAL dress code in the Clubhouse.

As a guide as to what is not currently acceptable members and visitors are requested to avoid wearing the following items of dress:

Clothing

- Wet and visibly mud stained golf attire,
- Outdoor coats, including rain coats, waterproofs and windcheaters
- Jeans
- Emblazoned team sport shirts (eg. football, rugby and cricket shirts) or collarless tee shirts (other than those specifically designed for golf)
- Trousers and any shorts with visible outside pockets (combats)
- Track suits.

Caps

- Not allowed in the club house.

Footwear

- Trainers, golf shoes, flip flops or flip flop thong-type sandals.

Ladies are requested to observe the spirit of the dress code where, because of differences in male and female attire, it is inappropriate for them to observe the code to the letter.

Mobile Phones

The use of a mobile phone on the course is not allowed, except in an emergency or for members of the medical profession who are on call. Phones can be switched to silent whilst in the clubhouse, but cannot be used in upstairs rooms or on the balcony.
